CHAPEL ORGAN

The chapel organ was built in 1935 by Casavant Frères of Sainte-Hyacinthe, Québec. The instrument is the firm's opus 1506, and consists of 24 ranks of pipes. The main organ and console are in the rear gallery, and there is a small echo organ above and to the left of the crucifix. Several tonal changes have been made since the instrument's original installation.

In 2014, Patrick J. Murphy and Associates of Stowe, Pennsylvania (www.pjmorgans.com) will rebuild the instrument. The mechanism will be renewed and the console will be updated with the latest solid state technology. Existing pipework will be thoroughly cleaned and voiced for optimal speech. Several vintage pipe ranks will be added to allow the instrument to be more successful in leading congregational singing, accompanying, and rendering the organ literature.
